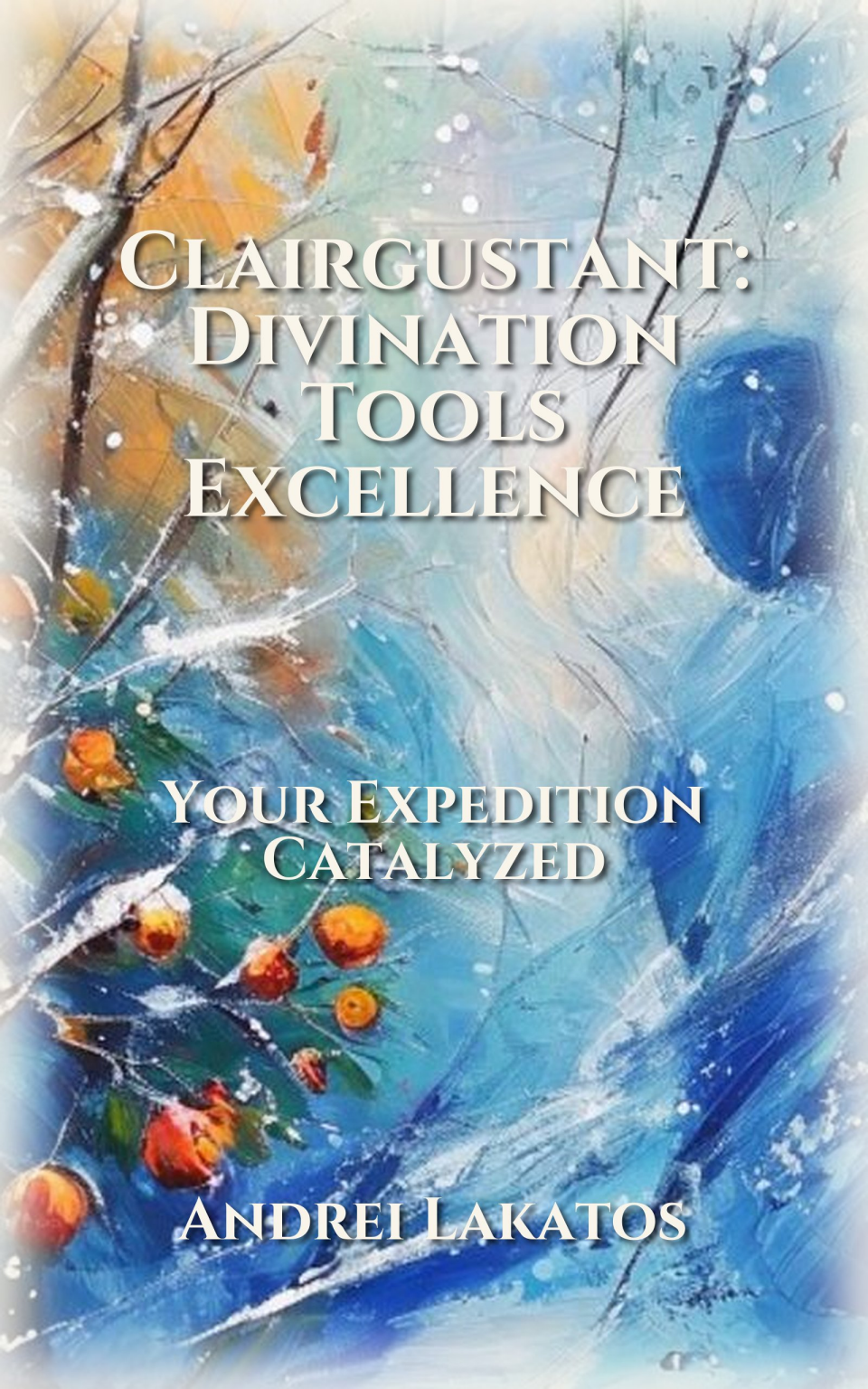

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CHAPTER 1

You find yourself comparing these disparate flavor impressions—the bitterness from work, the muted gray-brown from love—and noticing they share a common foundational note: the faint, underlying taste of unrinsed salt. This pattern suggests that the core blockage isn't professional dissatisfaction or emotional misalignment alone; it's a fundamental issue with perceived self-worth, perhaps an inability to properly cleanse one's energetic boundaries. At times, this constant overlay challenges your grounding, making you question if you are merely experiencing gustatory confusion because of dietary changes rather than

accessing deep layers of information. Picture this scenario: you are conducting a deep dive into ancestral memory using three distinct scrying materials laid out before you. First, you begin with a pool of dark, still water, which yields nothing visually compelling but leaves on your tongue the profound, muddy flavor of undisturbed riverbed silt mixed with aged cedar—a taste suggesting deeply rooted, yet stagnant, lineage knowledge.
