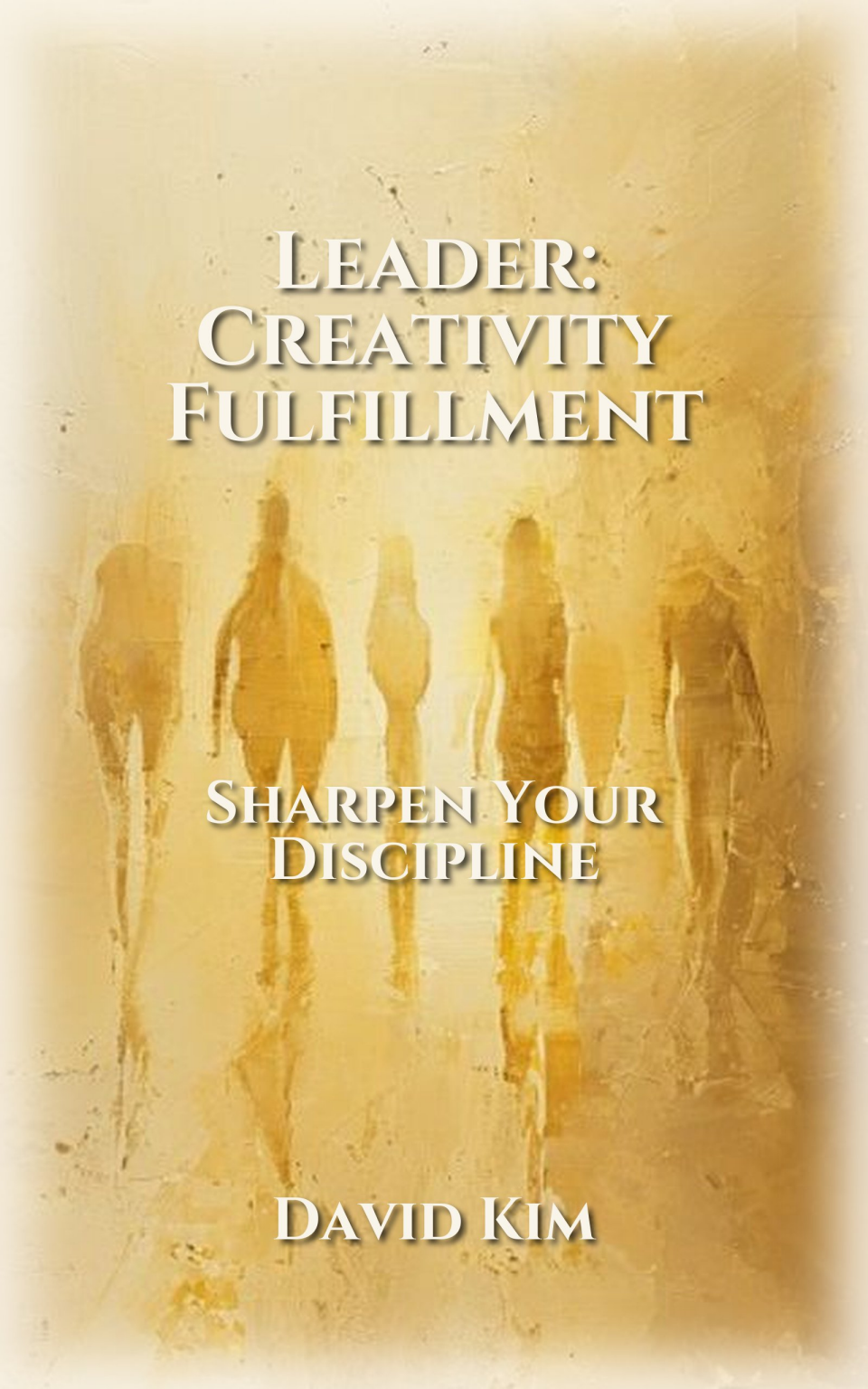




LEADER: CREATIVITY FULFILLMENT
