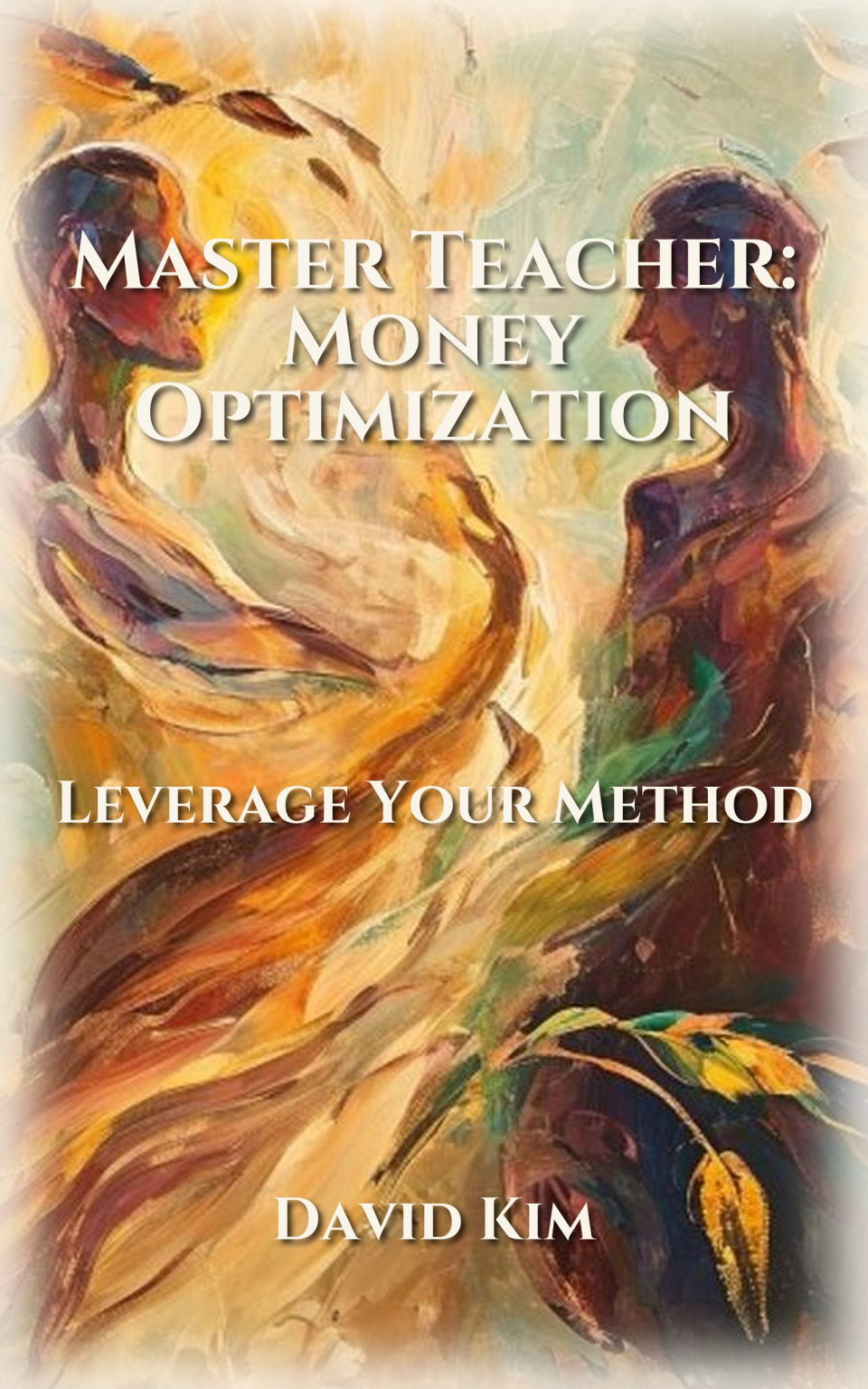




MASTER TEACHER: MONEY OPTIMIZATION
